Feast of Christ the King



This Sunday is the final Sunday of the liturgical year, when we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. On this day we proclaim Jesus as Lord of all, King of the Universe! However, this King doesn't reign from a throne: He doesn't wear a crown. He doesn't wear precious clothes. He hangs from a wooden Cross, wears a crown of thorns and His body shows the marks of His torture and crucifixion. Jesus is our king He has because won ultimate battle no other king in this world could win, the battle against sin, darkness and death by His crucifixion. The second reading from Colossians tells us that Jesus is the head of the

Church and the image of God. Everything was created through Him and for Him. His kingdom is not like the kingdoms of the world. It is not based on power or wealth but on love and mercy and salvation. We can see this love and mercy in the Gospel this Sunday. We see Jesus on the cross, crucified between two thieves. One insulted Him, but the other defended Him. The second criminal admitted his guilt asked and Jesus to remember him. Jesus did not reject him. Instead, He promised him a place in paradise. He does not turn away sinners. welcomes those who seek Him. He does not ask for great achievements or perfect lives. He asks for faith and trust. Jesus wants to be king of our lives not just part of our lives but all our ups and downs of everyday. He wants to live fully in us and as Christians this should be our number one desire. How do we achieve this? Through we find Church where the Sacraments. Baptism, the Eucharist and the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Through the Sacraments we have a constant connection to Jesus to help us reach our goal of eternal salvation.
