Week beginning 30th November 2025 First Sunday of Advent



Today is the first Sunday of Advent and the beginning of the Church's new year. Advent means preparing and waiting; we are a people who celebrate the fact that Jesus has come, is here now in His Church, and will come again to judge the living and the dead. So Advent is a time when we prepare to celebrate His birth and presence in His Church and in our hearts and prepare for His coming again at the end of the world. Each of us will meet Him the day we die.

In the first reading from the prophet Isaiah, all the tribes and nations of the world will come together to worship the Lord on God's holy mountain. Having been transformed by God they will all be unified in their praise of Him and God will be their judge and through His justice there will be peace on earth. St Paul has an urgent message for us: the time is now to pay attention, wake up from our spiritual slumber, do not be foolish. Get our life in proper order by

putting God first and recognise the reality of eternal life. We are to walk in the light of Christ and his Gospel. In the Gospel Jesus tells us that no one knows the day or the hour that the Son of Man will return to judge the living and the dead: only the Father in heaven knows. Thus Jesus tells us the importance of being ready and prepared. Keep watch and be vigilant, we are told. The Church gives us another opportunity during Advent to look at ourselves again, to open our hearts fully to Christ and to make a new beginning. If we want a relationship with Jesus, we can find Him in His Church, that is where He is primarily present to us in the Holy Eucharist. In all the Sacraments He comes to us to nourish and sustain us on our journey through life. Βv our continuous and regular attendance Holy Mass at we grow knowledge and grace and our faith grows stronger giving us confidence and the hope that we all need as we go from this world to eternal life with God.
