# Week beginning 9th November 2025



The Dedication of the Lateran celebrated Basilica is 9<sup>th</sup> November and this year it falls on a Sunday. The Dedication of Basilica the Lateran is an important moment for Catholics. This basilica, located in Rome, is the cathedral church of the Pope and is called the "mother of all churches." One of Pope Leo's first visits was across the city to pray at this cathedral church of St. John Lateran. The readings this Sunday reflect its significance. They remind us that we are God's living temple and called holiness and worship. second reading, St Paul to the Corinthians, we hear 'Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you.... "for the temple of God, which you are, is holy". In the First reading from Ezekiel, we see life-giving water flowing from the temple, "wherever the river flows, every sort of living creature that can multiply shall live". It is a sign of God's grace flowing out from Him and giving life to all that it touches. In the Gospel, when Jesus speaks of the temple's destruction and raising up in three days, He is referring to his own death and resurrection. Pointing to His body as the new temple. It was only after the Resurrection that the disciples came to understand the meaning of Jesus' words. As temples of God's Holy Spirit, we are called to purify our hearts, live with integrity, faith and love. God gives us the grace to do this through the Holy Eucharist. In a divided world, let us strive every day to radiate Christ's presence to
