Pope Leo XVI - Blessing to the World

Dear brothers and sisters, "Let us all rejoice in the Lord, for our Savior has been born in the world. Today, true peace has come down to us from heaven" (Entrance Antiphon, Christmas Mass during the Night). Thus sings the liturgy on Christmas night, and the announcement of Bethlehem resounds in the Church: the Child born of the Virgin Mary is Christ the Lord, sent by the Father to save us from sin and death. Indeed, he is our peace; he has conquered hatred and enmity through God's merciful love. For this reason, "the Lord's birth is the birth of peace" (Saint Leo the Great, Sermon 26).

A Year of a New Beginning

As we stand at the threshold of a New Year, we give thanks for new beginnings. We pray that the peace of God may dwell deeply in our hearts and in our homes, renewing us with hope and courage. As a parish and wider community, may we be gifted with **the grace to begin again**—together—trusting God's gentle guidance as we walk into 2026. In the words of Brendan Kennelly, "Begin again." May this simple invitation shape our prayer, our relationships, and our shared journey of faith in the year ahead.
