Dear parishioners we are currently distributing the box of envelopes to those in our Parish Envelope System. I wish to sincerely thank all who so generously support the Parish of Glenflesk and personally I'm truly grateful to all who contribute to my own yearly salary. Your loyalty and generosity are central to the life of our parish. I also would like thank to our Parish Secretary, Jackie, for her tremendous behind-the-scenes work, and to our dedicated Parish Council for all they do, including delivering the boxes of envelopes to each home. It is hoped all boxes will be delivered before Christmas, ready for use in 2026.
