Monsignor Hugh O'Flaherty - Centenary of his ordination. Monsignor O'Flaherty was one of the world's greatest humanitarians. He was ordained to the priesthood on the 20th of Dec 1925. To mark this special centenary, An Post has issued a commemorative stamp, and there is an exhibition about his life in Killarney Library, which is open to the public up to the 17th of January. Monsignor O'Flaherty was born in Kiskeam, and he grew up in Killarney. After many years of service in Rome, and his heroic life-saving work during World War II, he retired to Cahersiveen. He is interred in Cahersiveen Church Grounds. A commemorative Mass will be celebrated in Cahersiveen Church, at 6pm on Saturday, the 20th of Dec.
