You are invited to bring the Baby Jesus figure from your home to Mass that weekend to be blessed.

Restoration Update: we would like to thank all parishioners for your patience while the final elements of the refurbishment works are being completed. Once this is finished, all benches can be installed in their final positions and the remaining under-pew heaters can then be installed.
