## Week beginning 21st December 2025 Fourth Sunday of Advent & 28th December – Feast of the Holy Family



This Sunday is the Fourth Sunday of Advent. We are approaching Christmas and the readings reflect this and help us focus on who Jesus is and why He came. Isaiah speaks of a sign—a child born to a virgin. This child will be called Emmanuel, which means God is with us. Each reading gives us something to think about. Paul in the second reading speaks about Jesus identity, being both human and divine and in the Gospel the prophecy of Isaiah is fulfilled. Joseph planned divorce Mary quietly when he found out she was pregnant not by him. An angel told him in a dream to take her as his wife because the child was from the Holy Spirit. We are reminded that God always keeps His promises and the Gospel shows us how this promise was fulfilled. We must listen to God and trust in His plan, even when things uncertain. Joseph listened to and trusted God. He probably did not understand everything, but when the angel spoke to him in a dream, he obeyed. He chose faith over fear. Because of his trust, Joseph became part of God's great plan. The quiet and humble figure of Joseph is an inspiration for us. He was obedient to God and courageous. He accepted God's will. When disappointments in life make us wearv we often doubt the presence of God. But it was Joseph's faith and belief that helped him to cope positively rather than act rashly. Let us pray for that faith and belief in Jesus as members of His Church, this fourth Sunday of Advent and ask the Holy Spirit to help us stay strong, remain faithful and guide us every day, helping us take the next step in God's plan for us.
