Eigse na Brídeoige 2026
30 January - 1 February

Eigse na Brídeoige returns to the Iveragh Peninsula from 30
January to 1 February, bringing together poetry, music, song,
talks and book launches in Caherdaniel, Ballinskelligs, and Cillin
Liath. Founded in 1993 by Paddy and Fíona Bushe, this much-loved
festival continues its long-standing mission to celebrate the rich
culture, language and heritage of Iveragh.

Over the past twenty-seven years, Eigse na Brídeoige has
explored themes deeply rooted in the life and history of the
peninsula, including folklore, the song-singing tradition of
Iveragh, poetry, the sea, climate change, Skellig Michael, and
many other aspects of local heritage. Each year offers a fresh
lens through which to engage with the place and its people.

This year's festival is especially meaningful, as it celebrates the
work of one of our own, the great **Paddy Bushe**, whose
contribution to Irish literature and to the cultural life of Iveragh
is immeasurable. Eigse na Brídeoige 2026 offers an opportunity
to celebrate Paddy and to give thanks, he whose words and work
continue to inspire.
