The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God & Savior of the World. The great Feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the Magi from the East, representatives of the neighboring pagan religions. Our celebrations for this Holy Day of Obligation are:

January 5th - Vigil Mass

January 6th - Feast Day

Caherdaniel - 9:30am
