The Franciscan Friars of the Renewal are a new Community that come from the slums of the Bronx in New York city. The brothers live a life of great simplicity only living in neighbourhoods noted for poverty. They rely on the providence of God to survive. Their main mission is working with the poor & evangelization. They have two houses in Ireland: Derry & Limerick. The brothers in Limerick live in Moyross & run youth clubs, prayer groups, parish missions & other activities where they often bring people into real encounters with Jesus.

3 of the 5 brothers in Moyross are Irish. The friars have a reputation for great preaching & powerful parish missions. Their missions include healing nights where the Lord often performs healings & miracles. During the upcoming mission they will host opportunities for confessions, inner healing & physical healings. The brothers coming are Fr Oisín, Fr Columba, Fr Bernardino & Br Raphael. Fr Columba is internationally known for his popular online program Called to More (<https://www.calledtomore.org/>). The brothers are known also for their joy & humour; and people like the fact they are very down to earth.
