11th Sunday in Ordinary Time- Gospel Reflection: In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus looks upon
the crowds with deep compassion because they are "troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a
shepherd." His heart is moved by their needs, their struggles, and their longing for guidance and
hope. He then tells His disciples that the harvest is plentiful but the labourers are few, inviting
them to pray for the workers in God's harvest.

Jesus does more than ask for prayers: he sends His disciples out to continue His mission. He gives
them authority to heal, to proclaim the Kingdom of God, and to bring hope to those in need. Their
mission is not based on their own strength but on the gift and grace they have received from Him.

This Gospel reminds us that every Christian is called to be a disciple and a missionary. In our
families, workplaces, schools, and communities, we are invited to be signs of God's compassion
and love. As we have freely received God's blessings, so we are called to share them generously
with others through kindness, service, and faith.

May we respond with open hearts to the Lord's call and become joyful workers in His harvest.
