Ash Wednesday, falling on February 18, 2026, marks the start of the 40-day Lenten season, a period of repentance, fasting, and preparation for Easter. It is a solemn day of prayer where Christians receive ashes on their foreheads, symbolizing mortality, humanity's need for God's mercy, and a commitment to spiritual renewal. **The Sign of Ashes:** Ashes—made from burnt palms from the previous year's Palm Sunday—are placed on the forehead, usually with the sign of the cross, accompanied by the words "Repent, and believe in the Gospel" or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return".

TROCAIRE – 2026 This year's Lent Campaign accompanies a three-generation family in rural Rwanda, led by Uwamahoro, a young mother supporting her daughter, niece and elderly mother. Through their story, parish communities are invited to reflect on themes of resilience, care for our common home, and the dignity of every person in the face of poverty caused by climate injustice. Their lived experience helps bring the Sunday Gospels to life and connects faith with the call to solidarity
