

It will start with the Raising of our National Flag (The Tri Colour) accompanied by a roll of the drums by Christopher Byrnes. A decade of the Rosary for the Repose of the Souls of all who died during the War of Independence. This will be followed by singing of the National Anthem by Sheila Fitzgerald, a reading of the Proclamation by Noel Keating, followed by a short talk on the Ambush by Pat O'Brien & a reading of the Late Bill Coady recitation Clonbanin Ambush, recited by Dan Joe O'Keeffe.
