3RD WEEK OF LENT: Focusing on Stations of the Cross

Mon: Jesus is condemned to death , Jesus takes up his Cross, Jesus falls for the first time.

Tues: Jesus meets his Mother, Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus, Veronica wipes the face of Jesus

Wed: Jesus falls for the second time, Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem

Jesus falls for a third time

Thurs: Jesus is stripped of his clothes , Jesus is nailed to the Cross

Fri: Jesus dies on the Cross, Jesus is taken down from the Cross , Jesus is laid in the tomb

Sat: Jesus is raised from the dead.
