I share words by my late Parish Priest Fr Kevin, who sadly passed away unexpectedly on the 21st December 2021, from one of his newsletters. His words ring true from Heaven to each of our hearts this Easter: He says:

"We all experience moments of dying in our lives.

We get a foretaste of death when we live in bitterness, when prejudice blinds us, when loneliness enfolds us, when fears oppress us, when sadness overwhelms us and when we give into despair.

In those moments, the world is closing in on us and we have one foot already in the grave.

But we also experience moments of resurrection in our lives, when we know true love, when we are accepted, when we are forgiven, when we open our hearts to others and when hope returns.

In those moments our horizon is widening, and we are emerging from the tomb.

Risen Jesus, may the power of your Resurrection light up our hearts and our lovely Parish, scattering the shadows of death and helping all of us to walk and rejoice in your ways. Amen".
