Like Thomas, there are moments when we find it difficult to see the signs of the Risen Christ, or, better, to see him present in the signs that are given. How can a cancer diagnosis be a sign of the Risen Christ? How can a sense of isolation and loneliness, of betrayal and vulnerability be signs of a new life of peace and joy? Yet, if they are not, that means the Resurrection is inauthentic. If Christ is risen, then He is risen also in the places where we are lonely, vulnerable, betrayed and isolated. That is the Thomas lesson.
