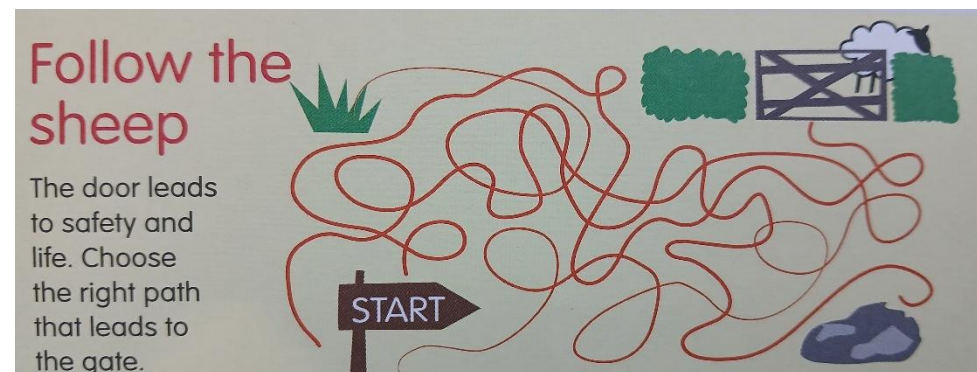

Thought for the Week: Vocation Sunday – Good Shepherd Sunday
