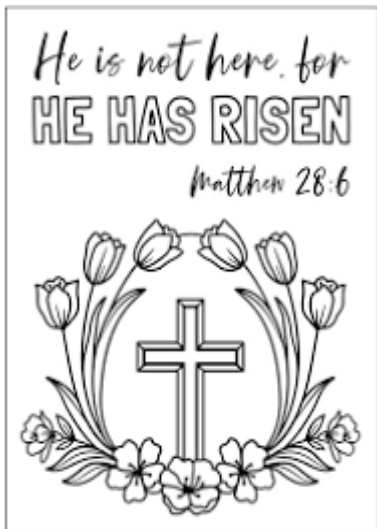

Today we rejoice and celebrate the incredible miracle of the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ from the dead.

This week we have accompanied Him through His passion and crucifixion and today we hear in the Gospel of John an account of His Resurrection as he promised it would happen on the third day. Our entire faith is based on Jesus rising from the dead. St Paul tells us in Corinthians ' if Jesus didn't rise from the dead, we are the most pitied of all people, our preaching is useless and we are still in our sins.' God's love and mercy

has overcome evil, sin and death; the World will never be the same again. A new life has opened up for all people, eternal life. Everyone who believes in Jesus will have forgiveness of sins through His name if they repent. We can now be acceptable to God through His Son Jesus Christ. We can have a clear conviction that the Lord has risen. In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles Peter tells us that, "He became visible, not to all people, but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. He commissioned us to preach to the people and testify that He is the one appointed by God as Judge of the living and the dead.' Are we ready to go out and tell everyone He is risen and that He is still with us through His One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church, especially the Holy Eucharist at Mass and will never leave us and we can thrust that we will rise with Him to eternal life with God.
