The Spirit does not ask us to be perfect. The Spirit asks us to be open. Even a small flame can brighten a dark room. In the same way, a simple word of encouragement, a prayer, or an act of love can bring God’s presence to someone who needs it most. As we celebrate this feast, may we pray: “Come, Holy Spirit, fill our hearts with your peace, your strength, and your joy.”
