Trinity Sunday**



Today we celebrate the Feast of the most Holy Trinity; three divine persons in one God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Triune God is revealed to us in Scripture by Jesus Himself. As Son of God sent from the Father, Jesus has told us to call God 'Our Father' and has spoken to us many times about the Father during His life on earth. During His life Jesus promised the disciples that He would send the Holy Spirit after He had returned to the Father. At Pentecost the Holy Spirit was poured out on the Church by both Jesus and His Father. We are all baptised in 'The name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit'. In the Gospel today Jesus tells us that 'God so loved

the world that He gave His only begotten Son, so that everyone who believes in Him may not be lost but may have eternal life. For God sent His Son into the world not to condemn the world, but so that through Him the world might be saved, God's relationship with us is a story of love and self-sacrifice. He cares for us so much He sent His only Son to be condemned and crucified for our sins. By the power of the Holy Spirit, we are enabled to follow and believe in Jesus. By loving one another as a community we are reflecting the Holy Trinity and their community of perfect love, sharing and unity working together, three as one for the salvation of the world. This is the essence of our faith; God created us out of love making us in His image and likeness. We can never deserve Jesus' immense love and sacrifice for us, all we can do is accept this gift of salvation that reflects how much He loved the world. That should motivate us to live a life of gratitude and community building. Glory be to the Father, to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. Amen

The primary purpose of the Holy Mass is to worship God through participation in the re-

presentation of Jesus' passion, death and Resurrection. The Secondary purpose is to receive Jesus in Holy Communion and thirdly to unite as God's Church sharing Faith and Thanksgiving.
