Magnificent Humanity – 'Magnifica Humanitas' – Pope Leo's Encyclical, which was published this week. The following are some quotes from it.

“The magnificent humanity created by God stands today before a decisive choice: to erect a new Tower of Babel or to build the holy city, where God and humanity dwell together.”

“An understanding of the human being cannot be separated from the Incarnation, for ‘only in the mystery of the Incarnate Word does the mystery of man find true light’.

Without this reference, progress risks reducing the person to a function, a statistic, or a performance.”

“The encyclical distinguishes various dimensions of dignity, but emphasises one decisive aspect, which does not depend on circumstances or individual abilities. It is clearly stated that there exists ‘a deeper, more important level, which consists in “ontological dignity”’ specifying that this ‘belongs to every human being simply by virtue of their existence’.”
