Today the 11th week in ordinary time, we hear Moses lead the Israelite people to God. They agreed to obey God as their Lord and He embraced them as his people. In the Second reading St Paul tells us Jesus brought us back to God by dying for us while we were still sinners, saving us and giving us eternal life. We are indeed a privileged people. We are assured that we can claim our inheritance if we have faith and trust in Jesus Christ. In the Gospel Jesus looks at a crowd of people with pity and compassion knowing they are

in need of care and direction 'like sheep without a shepherd'. He calls His Apostles together to begin His Church whose mission is to go out and spread His truth, light and hope to the whole world; to freely give of themselves and serve the people in all their needs. The Apostles have been with Jesus listening and learning from Him and with the grace of the Holy Spirit can bring forgiveness and healing to the people. When we surrender to Jesus Christ and accept Him as our Lord and Saviour we can be moulded and changed into His likeness. We can then go out strengthened by prayer and the Sacraments and be witnesses for Christ helping others to come to know Him.

**Do you know the purpose of
Holy Mass?**

The primary purpose of the Holy Mass is to worship God through participation in the re-presentation of Jesus' passion, death and Resurrection. The Secondary purpose is to receive Jesus in Holy Communion and thirdly to unite as God's Church sharing Faith and Thanksgiving.
