The Corpus Christi procession will take place after the 11.30am Mass in St. Mary's, weather permitting. This is the order of the procession as it leaves the Church. It will proceed back Main Street, around by Fitzgerald's bar and up the Forge Road to the church for Benediction in the Church yard.

1. Cross Bearer
2. Part of the Congregation
3. The car with speaker and those leading the Rosary
4. The choir
5. The rest of the congregation
6. The Altar Servers
7. The First Holy Communion children
8. The Priest with the Blessed Sacrament

Please be silent and reverent before the Blessed Sacrament and participate in the Rosary and singing.

Plan B - If the weather is inclement, there will be Exposition

of the Blessed Sacrament in Church directly after Mass. We will begin with an opening hymn and then the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary ending with Benediction and a final hymn.

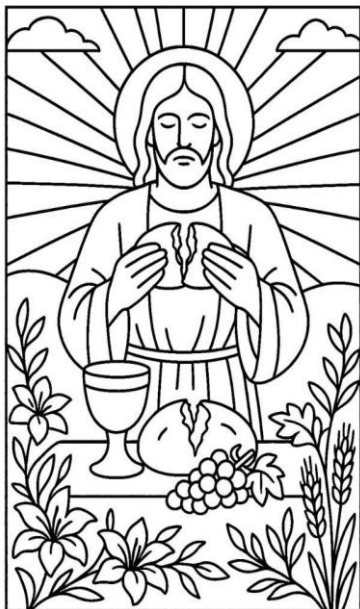

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ - Corpus Christi. The Eucharist is the source and summit of our Christian faith. Jesus is the Bread of Life. He is the Living Bread that has come down from heaven to give life to the world. In today's Gospel Jesus tells His followers that they must eat His flesh and drink His Blood to have life. The teaching was hard for many people to accept and some turned away because they did not understand. But Jesus did not

change His words. He wanted people to know that the Eucharist is not just a symbol, it is His real Presence, given to us to bring life.

Jesus is giving Himself totally to us in the Eucharist. He is inviting us to be one with Him so that we can live and love as He does. He also gives us strength to face our struggles and sufferings, trusting in Him to see us through. Jesus gives us everything we need and we need to recognise the amazing gift of the Eucharist with reverence and devotion. So today let us reflect on the gift of the Eucharist and know that Jesus is living here and now in us and in our neighbour. Let us give thanks with grateful hearts and deepen our trust in Jesus.

The primary purpose of the Holy Mass is to worship God through participation in the representation of Jesus' passion, death and Resurrection. The Secondary purpose is to receive Jesus in Holy Communion and thirdly to unite as God's Church sharing Faith and Thanksgiving.
