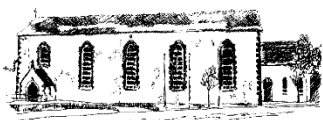

Bus will depart Knock @ 4.30pm stopping at O'Sullivan's Gort on the journey home.
- **Youth2000 Ireland Annual Summer Festival Youth 2000 Ireland (aged 16 - 35) are currently preparing for their annual Summer Festival which will take place from Thursday 13th – Sunday 16th August in Newbridge College Co. Kildare.** This event brings together young people from across the country for a time of prayer, community and encounter with Christ.
