Parish Pilgrimage to Assisi June 2026

On Monday June 8th last, the first group of our parishioners set out on their Laudato Si Parish Pilgrimage to Assisi.

Seeking both the teaching and the pathways of St. Francis – care for each other and care for our 'common home' – they journeyed by bus, plane and by foot. On Friday June 12th, the second group of parish pilgrims set out; all of us together, on the same mission. Over 135 kms was traversed and over 3,000m in height was gained.

To guide and accompany us, a parish pilgrimage booklet was prepared, entitled 'Via di Francesco.' Notable quotes from the booklet are 'O Divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console....' And 'May God bless us with anger at injustice, oppression and exploitation of people and of the earth...' and, to close, a beautiful prayer entitled The Beatitudes of the Pilgrim.

On several Umbrian evenings, and across several Umbrian valleys, villages and hillsides, 'An Poc ar Buile' and 'The Ceannovree Biddy Ball' and other songs rang out as our pilgrims laughed, shared stories and became companions to one another as we journeyed, step by step, to Assisi.

The challenge now, on our return, is to rise to St. Francis' words of praising the Lord in the wonders of creation and addressing the evermore pressing needs of climate breakdown, migration and needless hunger, to name but two.
