On next Saturday (19th) our Parish Pastoral Council, in conjunction with the Diocesan Justice, Peace & Integrity Committee will host a Season of Creation Celebration between 1.30 & 3.30p.m. This afternoon is open to everyone and will give Parishioners and the Diocese an opportunity to see the work that has been done as part of our Bio-diversity project with our overall objective being to return 30% of Parish ground to nature by 2030.

Those attending will tour our grounds commencing in the Church where our choir and musicians will welcome everyone, proceeding to the rear of our Parish Centre while viewing the progress of the work done through photographs displayed at different intervals, continuing through the Presentation Convent cemetery into the Old Parish Cemetery and returning to the Parish Centre for refreshments. At different points along the way there will be an opportunity to meet some of those involved in the various projects undertaken, including the bee bank, wildflower garden, our fruit shrubs garden, the artists involved in the making of the ceramic tiles for our Creation Way walk, pupils from the Community School who designed and made our swift boxes and children from Cloghoul N.S with some produce which they have grown in their school. At 2.00p.m. there will be a blessing of the ground. We hope you can join us and acknowledge the tremendous work that is being done in our Parish.
