Jesus, I Trust in You: St Faustina & the Message of Divine Mercy

As St Faustina's life in religious life deepened, so did her relationship with Jesus. She received profound mystical experiences in which Christ revealed the depth of His mercy and His desire for every person to turn to Him with trust. Jesus asked Faustina to record these experiences, and her humble obedience gave us her [Diary: Divine Mercy in My Soul](#). Through her writings, we are reminded that God's mercy is always greater than our weakness, our failures and our fears.

One of the great gifts of these encounters was the image of Divine Mercy. Faustina was asked to have the image painted according to the vision she received: [Jesus with rays of red and pale light flowing from His heart, and the words, "Jesus, I trust in You."](#) How blessed we are as a parish to have our own beautiful, hand-painted image of Divine Mercy in the Oratory, created by Majella Roddy of Cahersiveen during the difficult days of Covid. At a time when so many were experiencing uncertainty, isolation and fear, this image became a powerful reminder of Christ's presence and His unfailing mercy.

The message entrusted to St Faustina has now spread throughout the world, bringing hope and consolation to countless people. We do not need extraordinary experiences to follow her example. We are simply invited to trust Jesus, receive His mercy, and share that mercy with others. This week, perhaps we can pause before our image of Divine Mercy and pray those simple words with St Faustina: "Jesus, I trust in You." In a world so much in need of hope and compassion, that prayer can become a gift we carry to others.
