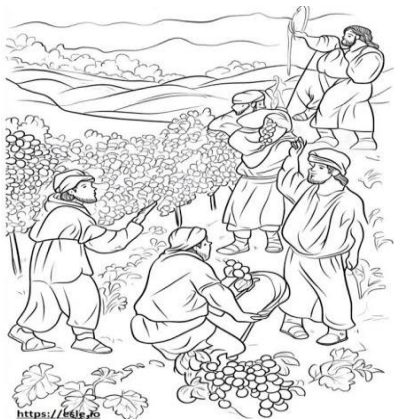

In today's Gospel we are challenged. The owner of the vineyard pays all the workers the same amount irrespective of the length of time they were working. To many of us this seems very unjust, but God's ways are not our ways. We are challenged to look at how we live, work and care for each other. We are the workers in the Lord's vineyard. We are especially aware of the need to take of God's gifts to us.

Our duty is to share our resources with those who are hungry because God has created enough food for everyone, greed can destroy God's plan that everyone has enough. God expects us to

use the earth and its resources for our sustenance with respect and remember that we are the stewards of this earth for the next generation. Like the owner of the vineyard, God is asking us to work for the common good, to help the poor and marginalised, to give a voice to those who have none. Everyone needs to be valued and encouraged.
