In the first reading today, the prophet Ezekiel tells us that God remembers his mercy for us when we repent of our sins. In the Gospel Jesus is talking to the scribes and Pharisees. He knows and sees the false image they portray pretending to believe and follow the law of God, their hypocrisy is very obvious He told them a story of a father and his two sons: The first son represented the Pharisees, those who said “yes” but did not have any intention of promoting the truth and following God. The second son represented the sinners who initially said “no” to God but having listened to His call

repented and turned back to Him. We can ask ourselves which one we are. Are we paying more attention to following on Facebook and social media when Jesus Christ is the most important Person we will ever follow. Do our actions match our beliefs? Jesus tells us He did not come for the virtuous; He came to call sinners to repent and seek reconciliation. God is always waiting for us to admit our faults and come to Him for forgiveness and healing. He died on the cross for us so that we can have eternal life. He calls us to conversion continually if we are listening. Do we hear his voice and answer the call? Do we follow His word and believe in His Church? When we encounter Jesus, we find everything we need to be happy. When we turn away from sin then we can live with God for eternity.

The primary purpose of the Holy Mass is to worship God through participation in the representation of Jesus’ passion, death and Resurrection. The Secondary purpose is to receive Jesus in Holy Communion and thirdly to unite
